# "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NEW 'PARKING' AND 'NO PARKING' ZONES ON PORTION OF W. WALNUT STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF BOLIVAR, MO."

Be it Ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Bolivar, Missouri, as follows:

**Section I:** It shall be unlawful for the operator of a motor vehicle to park said motor vehicle at any one time or instance at the following location: There shall be no parking on the South side of W. Walnut Street at any time for that section of W. Walnut in the 300 block between Pike Street and Clark Street. The foregoing provisions will become effective immediately upon the placement of adequate and clearly legible signs stating the designation of the specified section of W. Walnut Street as a no-parking area along such streets and roadways and intersections. The Bolivar Municipal Code, Title III – Traffic Code; Schedule II – No Parking, may be amended to reflect the designation of said section of W. Walnut Street as a no-parking area.

**Section II:** There shall be allowed parking on the North side of W. Walnut Street for that section of W. Walnut in the 300 block between Pike Street and Clark Street. The foregoing provisions will become effective immediately upon the placement of adequate and clearly legible signs stating the designation of the specified section of W. Walnut Street as a parking area along such streets and roadways and intersections. The Bolivar Municipal Code, Title III – Traffic Code; Schedule II – No Parking, may be amended to reflect the changed designation of said section of W. Walnut Street.

**Section III**: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen and approval by the Mayor.
