Applications are now being accepted for the position of firefighter by the Bolivar City Fire Department. The starting salary for a firefighter at BCFD is approximately \$34,000. The City of Bolivar provides a full package of benefits for all of its employees. BCFD crews run on a 48/96 rotating schedule.

We will be accepting applications for these positions through noon (12:00 PM) on December 13, 2019, with interviews to occur December 18th, 2019. Candidates will be called on Friday December 13th, 2019 if selected for interviews.

BCFD only hires eligible candidates who have successfully completed the Tri-State Fire Recruiting Alliance testing process. However, consideration for those who have not successfully completed the Tri-State Fire Recruiting Alliance will be made, with conditional employment offers requiring passing this testing process at the next testing opportunity. Lateral transfers and other applicants will be considered if no acceptable qualified candidates apply from the Tri State Recruitment Alliance.

Applicants must be 18 years of age at time of employment, must possess High School Diploma or GED, must have a Valid Driver's License with a good driving record, must maintain all certifications as required by applicable NFPA standards at the discretion of the City and must possess the following accredited certifications and requirements:

1. Firefighter I & II (IFSAC or equivalent)
2. Hazardous Materials Operations Level
3. DOT Approved Medical First Responder,
(Candidates responsibility to obtain EMT Licensure within first year of employment)
4. AHA CPR for the Healthcare Provider
5. Tristate Alliance testing (physical ability test and written test)

Must be able to pass the following:

1. Physical capacity profile test
2. Background investigation
3. Pre-employment drug screening
