

ORDER

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020 the Board of Alderman for the City of Bolivar, MO passed Bill No. 2020-11 and thereby authorized the Mayor to declare public emergencies in time of need and to issue orders accordingly; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor declared a public emergency by proclamation on March 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has entered follow-up orders subsequent to the initial proclamation of March 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS, after consultation with city, county, and state officials, it is the Mayor's judgment that the follow-up Orders should be amended as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, CHRISTOPHER WARWICK, THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BOLIVAR, MISSOURI, DOES HEREBY PROCLAIM AND ORDER THAT:

1. All emergency Orders subsequent to the initial emergency proclamation of March 17, 2020 are hereby terminated; however, a public local emergency continues to exist throughout the City of Bolivar; and
2. During the existence of said local emergency the powers, functions and duties of the emergency organization of the City will be those prescribed by state law, and City ordinances.
3. Enaction of this Order will include a limit of gatherings of no more than 150 people in the City of Bolivar. Exceptions will be schools, daycares, businesses, and churches.
4. Notwithstanding the foregoing, when engaging in public activities, all personal, business or other activities will be subject to the "Show-Me Strong Recovery Order" as issued by the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services on April 27, 2020. Such Recovery Order is currently effective through and including May 31, 2020, unless otherwise amended or revoked.

5. This Order will be in effect from May 21, 2020 through and including May 31, 2020.
