*WHEREAS*, on March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020, Polk County Health Department hosted a meeting with community organizations and schools about the novel coronavirus being seen in parts of the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, the Health Department continued to monitor and establish a daily testing site for the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the Health Department coordinated weekly informational meetings and kept the community updated throughout the pandemic by speaking at numerous public events; and

**WHEREAS**, the Health Department has monitored over 3,000 confirmed cases of the Coronavirus in Polk County, Missouri and performed contact tracing and quarantine monitoring, to at times over 800 people a day; and

*WHEREAS*, while this pandemic is ongoing, the Health Department continues to provide normal resources to those in need including health screenings, regular vaccinations, WIC and food programs; and

**WHEREAS**, we still recognize that this pandemic is not over, but understand the service the Polk County Health Department has provided to Bolivar and the entire county; and
