Total Incidents by OFFENSE: BPD took 88 (95 in April) reports in May indicating the highest incident totals are stealing/theft violations, property damage, and assaults. (Incident report by statutes) (Graph attached: Day of week/Time of day) Most common day for offenses is Tuesday, at 1600 hours.

<u>CALLS FOR SERVICE:</u> BPD responded to 1357 (1259 for April) calls for service for the month of May. Reports indicate Monday at 1500 hours was peak time for calls for service to be generated and responded to. The highest calls for service include but not limited to: call backs, traffic stops, burglary, and animal calls.

ARREST: BPD Officers arrested/cited/cleared 34 (30 in April) offenses-warrants in May. Totals by violation and offense: Our highest number appear to be from warrant arrests and domestic assualt. (Arrest with all charges by date range)

<u>CITATIONS:</u> BPD issued 64 (45 in April) citations in May. Totals by violation indicate the highest total of citations include; No Proof of Insurance and Domestic Assault. (Summons/citation charge summary by date range)

Wildlife: Increased deer sightings have occurred.



WHEREAS, on or about January 31, 2022, the City of Bolivar, Missouri closed its sale of the City's water and sewer utilities to Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water) LLC; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bolivar recognized approximately \$23.5 million in direct proceeds from the sale closing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bolivar has been working on paying off outstanding lease/purchases, and interdepartmental transfers / budget adjustments with the direct proceeds of the sale; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bolivar has realized "indirect" proceeds from the sale, with "**Indirect Proceeds**" being defined for purposes of this Ordinance as the remaining balance in Fund 18 (the enterprise fund) pooled cash account, and Capital Improvement Tax revenues that will no longer be encumbered following the payoff of the City's various lease/purchase agreements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bolivar has determined that it would be in the public's best interest to use some of its Indirect Proceeds for certain expenditures as set forth herein.

Now Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Bolivar, Missouri, as follows:

Section I: The City does hereby approve fund transfers from the Water Sewer Fund of Indirect Proceeds to various funds for the approved purchases and expenses board approved as outlined in the attachment(s) as recommended by the City Administrator, hereto labeled as Exhibit A and B, attached and made a part hereof by reference.

Section II: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen and approval by the Mayor.

Section; and if required by the City, such fees shall be paid in advance of the issuance of a grave opening permit.

- D. No section lot, burial space or grave shall be fenced.
- There shall be but one (1) ground flower per grave, except between the period of two (2) weeks prior to Memorial Day and June 30° in each year. Flowers or other decorations placed on tombstones shall not be restricted. In order for a family to save any decorations placed on a grave, the decoration should be removed prior to posted removal date. However, the City/cemetery reserves the right to remove all flowers, wreaths or other decorations from lots as soon as they become unsightly or when performing grounds cleanup (removed at the discretion of cemetery personnel).
 - F. No tombstone, grave marker, monument, bench or other type of permanent memorial and non-mausoleum shall be erected, placed or installed on any lot or lots or on any burial space or spaces, unless a permit for such erection, placement or installation has first been obtained from the cemetery Sexton or, in his/her absence, from the Mayor of the City or his/her designee. It shall be the duty of the Sexton to prepare an application showing the type and location of the proposed tombstone, grave marker, monument, bench or other type of memorial containing such information as is reasonably necessary to show compliances with the requirements of these regulations. The following rules and regulations shall govern installation and maintenance of tombstones and grave markers, monuments, benches or other permanent memorials.
 - 1. All headstones shall be placed on a concrete foundation with a minimum of an eighteen (18) inch depth.
 - 2. Small footstones shall be placed on a concrete foundation with a twelve (12) inch depth.
 - 3. All monuments, benches or other types of memorial serving a similar purpose shall be placed upon a concrete foundation that has a depth at least equal of its height.
 - The Sexton may require greater foundation depths if, due to the size of the proposed stone, monument or bench, soil type or other circumstances, safety required greater foundation depth.
 - 5. The foundation of all gravestones and grave markers shall have a minimum of a four-inch apron, except that the Sexton may waive the requirement for the four-inch apron if existing stones on the lot do not have such an apron; and appearance of the lot would be adversely affected by the deviation from existing markers.
 - 6. If there is more than one (1) marker on a grave space, only one (1) such marker may be above ground.
 - 7. In the case of a lot or partial lot containing two (2), four (4), six (6) or eight (8) burial spaces under common family ownership and an above ground family marker is substantially centered in any direction on such lot or partial lots, no further above ground monuments shall be permitted on any such burial spaces.
 - 8. The repair and maintenance of tombstones, grave markers, etc., are the responsibility of the family. If, however, the family is unavailable, the City will provide for necessary repairs.
 - 9. All above ground mausoleums should have a four (4) inch apron or such lesser apron as is necessary to abut a new mausoleum to an existing mausoleum. All mausoleum apron installations must be performed by a monument company, and all installation work must be completed within ninety (90) days of the date of internment.
 - 10. All above ground vaults shall be subject to prior approval of the Cemetery Committee, hereinafter established, as to location, type of construction and security measures.
 - G. No person under the age of sixteen (16) years should enter the cemetery unaccompanied by an adult, except solely for the purpose of visitation.
